Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Applications (sNDAs) dated and received on July 28, 2017 (Supplement 6) and October 18, 2017 (Supplement 7) and your amendments, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for PREZCOBIX<sup>®</sup> (darunavir/cobicistat) tablets, 800 mg/150 mg.

These Prior Approval supplemental new drug applications provides for the following changes:

- To update the DRUG INTERACTIONS Section (subsection 7.3, Table 2) with the following:
  - Addition of prednisone as an alternative corticosteroid to consider for coadministration
  - Dosage recommendations for HMG-Co A reductase inhibitors (atorvastatin and rosuvastatin)
  - Information regarding hormonal contraceptives, drospirenone and ethinyl estradiol
  - Information regarding co-administration with the platelet aggregation inhibitor ticagrelor
- To revise the DRUG INTERACTIONS subsection 7.4 Drugs without Clinically Significant Interactions with PREZCOBIX
- To update PATIENT INFORMATION'S "Who should not take PREZCOBIX" section

#### APPROVAL & LABELING

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We have completed our review of these supplemental applications, as amended. They are approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

## **CONTENT OF LABELING**

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at <a href="http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm">http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm</a>. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert, text for the patient package insert, Medication Guide), with the addition of any labeling changes in pending "Changes Being Effected" (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

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You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit the following, in triplicate, (1) a cover letter requesting advisory comments, (2) the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and (3) the package insert(s) to:
