1 Before the Court is the parties' Joint Stipulation to Stay Litigation. The parties

8 3. The parties are ORDERED to file a Joint Status Report every 60 days
9 regarding the status of the above petitions for *inter partes* review or within 10 days
10 of (1) a determination by the PTAB whether to institute any additional petitions; or
11 (2) the issuance of a Final Written Decision by the PTAB for any instituted requests
12 for *inter partes* review, whichever is earlier.
