NORTH AMERICA LLC's  
MOTION UNDER RULE 54(b) TO  
ENTER FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO  
COUNT I FOR INFRINGEMENT OF  
U.S. PATENT NO. 6,013,007**

1 Before the Court is the Motion of Plaintiff Philips North America LLC (“Philips”)  
2 pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b) requesting that the Court enter final judgment on Count I of  
3 Philips’s Amended Complaint asserting infringement of U.S. Patent No. 6,013,007 (“’007  
4 Patent”). The Court’s August 28, 2020 Claim Construction Order (Dkt. 102) found the asserted  
5 claims of the ’007 Patent invalid for indefiniteness, thereby completely resolving the ’007 Patent  
6 cause of action and removing it from the case. Having considered the Motion, the Court hereby  
7 finds that there is no just reason for delay in entry of a final and appealable judgment as to the  
8 ’007 Patent pursuant to Rule 54(b).
