

## **ORDER**

The Court, having considered the parties' Joint and Unopposed Motion to Continue the Hearing on Defendant's Partial Motion to Dismiss and Corresponding Reply Brief, and the date to issue a Scheduling Order, and good cause appearing therefor, GRANTS the motion, and order as follows:

The hearing on Defendant's Partial Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. 27) is continued until **July 17, 2023, at 1:30 PM.** 

Defendant's Reply on its Partial Motion to Dismiss is to be filed by July 3, 2023.

The date that the Court will issue a Scheduling Order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16(b) establishing dates for completion of discovery, the filing of motions, pretrial conference, and trial in the above-entitled case, is continued to July 27, 2023. Accordingly, the deadline for an early meeting of counsel is continued until 21 days in advance of the new July 27, 2023 date, and the deadline to file a report of such meeting is continued until 14 days after such meeting of counsel.
