- 3. Sky ATP as a solution is available in multiple different self-contained deployments distributed geographically across the world. Sky ATP has deployments in the

I have reviewed Juniper's sales documentation for SRX and Sky ATP, located at JNPR-FNJN_29028_00472484 and JNPR-FNJN_29028_00472485. The following table shows the number of SRX units that were sold and the number of paid Sky ATP licenses that were sold to SRX customers, by SRX ship-to destination country, from the time that Sky ATP was launched (fourth quarter of 2015) through the end of the first quarter of 2017 (March 2017):
