
**ORDER RE SEALING OF

The order granting in part defendant Finjan’s early motion for summary judgment on the ‘494 patent, filed under seal today, shall remain under seal until **AUGUST 28 AT NOON**, after which it will be filed on the public docket unless one or more parties propose redactions via an administrative motion to file under seal. Any such motion must fully comply with the applicable law and our Civil Local Rules, including Rule 79-5(b)’s requirement that sealing requests “be narrowly tailored to seek sealing only of sealable material.” Overbroad requests will be denied.
