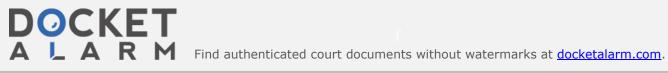

Plaintiff Finjan, Inc.'s ("Finjan") Administrative Motion to File Documents Under Seal was brought before this Court. Upon consideration of this motion and the supporting declaration of Austin Manes filed in support of the motion, the Court finds there to be good cause and compelling reasons for granting the request to file certain documents under seal.

GOOD CAUSE and compelling reasons having been shown, the Court finds that:

1. There exist overriding confidentiality interests that have overcome the right of public access to the record of the following documents:

Identification of Documents to be Sealed	Entity that Designated the Information to be Confidential
Finjan's Offer of Proof, page 2, lines 3-5, 28; page 5, line 20	Juniper

- 2. A substantial probability exists that the overriding confidentiality interests will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
 - 3. The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
 - 4. No less restrictive means exist to achieve these overriding interests.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Finjan's Administrative Motion to File Documents Under Seal is GRANTED with respect to the documents set forth above. IT IS SO ORDERED.
