1 **I. INTRODUCTION**

12 **II. ARGUMENT**

13 This Administrative Motion to File Documents Under Seal should be granted because good
14 cause and compelling reasons exist to seal the documents identified above. Finjan seeks to seal only
15 those documents and portions of documents that Juniper identified as containing confidential
16 information pursuant to the Protective Order. Finjan relies on Juniper’s representations and confidential
17 designations of these documents.

18 Exhibits 1 and 5 to the Kobiialka Declaration should be filed under seal as set forth in the
19 accompanying declaration of Kristopher Kastens in Support of this Administrative Motion because
20 these portions contain information that Juniper has designated as “Confidential” or “Highly
21 Confidential — Source Code.” Specifically, this information contains Juniper’s technical documents or
22 source code, or Juniper’s confidential business information, the public disclosure of which Juniper
23 claims could harm its business.

24 Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 79-5, Finjan has filed publicly the relevant excerpts of information
25 that are not confidential. Attached hereto are redacted and unredacted versions of the documents set
26 forth above.

2 For the foregoing reasons, Finjan respectfully requests that the Court grant this Administrative
3 Motion to File Documents Under Seal.
