Josh,

Finjan intends to seek leave to amend its complaint to assert Claims 1 and 17 of U.S. Patent No. 7,418,731 (the "731 Patent") against the already accused combination of SRX Gateways and Sky ATP. Juniper's infringement of these claims of the '731 Patent recently became apparent during the May 8th deposition of Yuly Tenorio, who described the internal structures of Sky ATP, including the manner in which profiles and files are stored and indexed.
