Impact	Category	Behavior
6	Fine-grained behavior	Checks hosts file and opens for reading
6	Evasion	Contains evasive sleep loops to bypass analysis
6	Obfuscation	Executable fails checksum test
6	Evasion	Performs checks for kernel debuggers
6	Obfuscation	Executable has sections with non-standard names
6	Exfiltration	Certificate file created
6	Obfuscation	Unusual PE entry point
6	Networking	Sets user agent to be a well known browser while communicating via HTTP
5	Persistence	Listens to changes in registry keys and values
4	Persistence	Application error messages muted
