Court modifies for this submission as set forth below:

No later than April 6, 2022, Plaintiff is to file a five-page brief regarding the issues in dispute. The Parties are to meet and confer in-person, in accordance with the above standing order, and to prepare a joint chart that sets forth in columns the disputed request, the response thereto, the parties' respective proposed compromises, and a blank column for the Court's use. If the Parties are unable to resolve the disputes through their meet-and-confer efforts, no later than April 18, 2022, Defendant AGIS Software Development LLC must file a five-page brief in response to Plaintiff's brief. Such response must include the final version of the joint chart as an exhibit.

The Parties are reminded that the chart is a summary of the Parties' positions, not a

restatement of argument. All other limitations set forth in the Court's standing order apply.
