Defendants have submitted a Notice of Motion and Motion to Dismiss that fails to comply with the local rules and this Court’s standing order. The notice and motion must be contained “[i]n one filed document not exceeding 25 pages in length.” Civ. L.R. 7-2(b). Defendants’ filing (ECF No. 38) includes a four-page notice in addition to a 25-page motion, which exceeds the page limit set by the local rules. Furthermore, Defendants’ motion also contains single-spaced footnotes with citations to evidence or case law. *See* Standing Order re Civil Cases § IV.F. The Notice of Motion and Motion to Dismiss is hereby STRICKEN. Defendants SHALL refile a compliant document no later than **October 23, 2023**.
