**PROCEEDINGS:**

- 1.) Defendant Blue Coat's Motion to Compel Discovery (Dkt. 108)**
- 2.) Plaintiff Finjan, Inc.'s Second Motion to Compel Discovery (Dkt. 109-3)**

The court grants Defendant's Motion to Compel Discovery.

As to documents pertaining to previous legal proceedings, documents to be produced no later than 14 days from today's date. No later than 7 days from today, Finjan to notice parties in cases who have not yet tendered consent that production has been entered by the court. Parties may seek relief from the court's order.

As to priority claims, Defendant must identify the specific limitations at issue in its remaining 24 claims within 7 days. Plaintiff shall identify where in the parent applications priority is justified within 21 days.

The court grants-in-part Plaintiff's Second Motion to Compel Discovery.

Plaintiff is permitted to take depositions of the 8 Blue Coat employees requested in its motion. Deposition hours will not be increased.

The court denies Plaintiff's request for response to Interrogatory No. 12.

The court grants Plaintiff's request for supplemental response to Request for Production No. 74.
