

22	Defendant provides the following response to the Court's Order Regarding Corrected	
23	Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings (Dkt. No. 59).	
24	On September 8, 2021, Triller filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings under 35 U.S.C	
25	§ 101 in accordance with the briefing schedule previously ordered by the Court pursuant to the	
26	parties' stipulation. (Dkt. No. 56.) Triller's motion was 25 pages in length, consistent with Local	
27	Rule 7-4(b), but inadvertently overlooking the fact that this Court's Standing Order No. 6 limits

such motions to 15 pages. On September 13, 2021, counsel for Plaintiffs notified Defendants that
Triller's motion was in excess of the 15-page limit specified in the Court's Civil Standing Order
No. 6 and demanded that Defendant re-file a brief in compliance with the page-limits of Civil
Standing Order No. 6.

On September 15, 2021, Defendant filed a corrected 15-page version of its motion for judgment on the pleadings (Dkt. No. 58). The Corrected Motion is a shortened version of the original motion. The basic arguments remain unchanged. Counsel for Plaintiffs requested additional time to respond to the corrected motion, and the Court's next available hearing date is November 5, 2021. Accordingly, Defendant agreed to November 5, 2021.

This response is accompanied by a stipulation by the parties agreeing that the default briefing schedule set forth in the local rules should govern for Triller's corrected motion, and that the motion should be set for hearing on November 5, 2021 instead of October 8, 2021.
