ORDER RE ADR DEADLINES

It has come to the Court's attention that in one or more cases comprising this multidistrict litigation ("MDL"), Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") deadlines set prior to transfer or consolidation to the MDL may remain in effect. See, e.g., PersonalWeb Techs. v. Peek Travel, *Inc.*, 5:18-cv-04628-BLF, at ECF 22.

At the Case Management Conference on September 20, 2018, the Court ordered that defendants in the "customer cases" (i.e. any case comprising this MDL other than the Amazon Declaratory Judgment action) shall not be required to respond to the operative complaint, unless and until ordered to do so by this Court. See Case Management Order No. 1 ¶ 3, ECF 157. The Court hereby orders that any ADR obligations in the "customer cases" are likewise on hold.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
