9 *Techs., LLC v. IBM Corp.*, No. 6:12-cv-661-JRG, Dkt. No. 103) regarding “licensed” and unlicensed,”  
10 namely, that “licensed” is construed as “having valid rights to content” and “unlicensed” is  
11 construed as “invalid rights to content.”
