

[PROPOSED] ORDER

Before this Court is the Motion to Compel Compliance with Court Order by Amazon.com, Inc., Amazon Web Services, Inc., and Twitch Interactive, Inc. (collectively, "Amazon"). Having considered the motion, as well as supporting documents filed therewith, the Court finds good cause to compel PersonalWeb Technologies, LLC ("PersonalWeb") to comply with the Court's April 27, 2021 order. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Amazon's motion as follows:

- PersonalWeb shall provide Amazon bank or financial accounts within Personal-Web's possession, including current balances by _____, 2021. Continuing non-compliance will be treated as contempt of Court.
- Leave is granted for Amazon to seek sanctions against PersonalWeb and Stubbs Alderton and Markiles, LLP for PersonalWeb's failure to comply with the Court's April 27, 2021 order.
