**[PROPOSED] ORDER**

Before this Court is the Joint Statement of Amazon.com, Inc., Amazon Web Services, Inc., Twitch Interactive, Inc. (collectively, “Amazon”) and third-parties Brilliant Digital Entertainment, Inc., Claria Innovations, LLC, Europlay Capital Advisors, LLC, and Monto Holdings Pty. Ltd. (collectively, “PersonalWeb Affiliates”). Having considered the parties’ Joint Statement, as well as supporting documents filed therewith, the Court finds good cause to compel the PersonalWeb Affiliates to comply with the Court’s orders (Dkts. 738 & 746).

Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Amazon’s motion as follows:

1. The PersonalWeb Affiliates shall each provide Amazon responses to the requests for production removing objections other than attorney-client privilege and work product protection within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
2. The PersonalWeb Affiliates shall produce all responsive non-privileged documents within any of their possession, custody, or control within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order.
3. The PersonalWeb Affiliates are ordered to reimburse Amazon’s costs and reasonable attorney fees in securing compliance with the Court’s previous orders. Amazon shall submit a declaration substantiating those costs and fees within fourteen (14) days of the date of this order.
