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[PROPOSED] ORDER

2 Before this Court is the Joint Statement of Amazon.com, Inc., Amazon Web Services, Inc.,
3 Twitch Interactive, Inc. (collectively, “Amazon”) and third-parties Brilliant Digital Entertainment,
4 Inc., Claria Innovations, LLC, Europlay Capital Advisors, LLC, and Monto Holdings Pty. Ltd.
5 (collectively, “PersonalWeb Affiliates”). Having considered the parties’ Joint Statement, as well
6 as supporting documents filed therewith, the Court finds good cause to compel the PersonalWeb
7 Affiliates to comply with the Court’s orders (Dkts. 738 & 746).

8 Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Amazon’s motion as follows:

- 9 1. The PersonalWeb Affiliates shall each provide Amazon responses to the
10 requests for production removing any financial privacy objection within seven
11 (7) days of the date of this Order.
- 12 2. The PersonalWeb Affiliates shall produce all responsive non-privileged
13 documents within any of their possession, custody, or control, including any
14 documents withheld on the basis of financial privacy, whether or not currently
15 reflected on the PersonalWeb Affiliates’ privilege log, within fourteen (14) days
16 of the date of this Order.
- 17 3. The PersonalWeb Affiliates are ordered to reimburse Amazon’s costs and
18 reasonable attorney fees in securing compliance with the Court’s previous
19 orders. Amazon shall submit a declaration substantiating those costs and fees
20 within fourteen (14) days of the date of this order.
