**ORDER STRIKING MOTION IN
SUPPORT OF FURTHER
SUPPLEMENTAL FEES REQUEST
FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE
COURT’S STANDING ORDERS**

On May 19, 2023, a motion in support of further supplemental fees request was filed. ECF No. 878. The Court STRIKES the motion for noncompliance with the Court’s Standing Order Re Civil Cases. And third, all motions’ for attorneys’ fees must include a chart in the format set forth in the Standing Order. *See id.* § VII. A corrected motion in support of further supplemental fees SHALL be filed by May 26, 2023.
