2	Before the Court is Plaintiff Applied Materials, Inc.'s ("Applied") Administrative Motion
3	for Leave to Lodge a New Declaratory Judgment Complaint ("Motion").
4	Having considered the issues presented in the Motion, the Motion is GRANTED.
5	[ALTERNATIVE #1]
6	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT Applied shall lodge the proposed new complaint
7	on this Court's docket as a separate docket entry.
8	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the complaint shall be deemed the operative
9	complaint in this action, and Demaray LLC ("Demaray") shall file a responsive pleading within
10	days. Demaray's pending motion to dismiss, Dkt. Nos. 39, 42, 43, is denied as moot.
11	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Applied shall voluntarily dismiss the new action,
12	Case No. 5:20-cv-9341.
13	[ <u>ALTERNATIVE #2</u> ]
14	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT Applied shall lodge the proposed new complaint
15	on this Court's docket as a separate docket entry.
16	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT in the new action, Case No. 5:20-cv-9341, Applied
17	shall file an administrative motion to consider whether these cases should be related, pursuant to
18	Local Rule 3-12.
19	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Demaray LLC's ("Demaray") motion to dismiss is
20	held in abeyance until the Court in Case No. 5:20-cv-9341 rules on Applied's administrative
21	motion to consider whether these cases should be related.
22	IT IS SO ORDERED.
