procedure. We're planning to start with a tutorial. And for that purpose my partner Tom Makin is going to present some testimony from our expert witness Professor Ben Goldberg who is here with us. Then at the end of that the other side will present a tutorial, ask any questions they want of Professor Goldberg, and then we would start the Markman.

And we've split that up. I'm planning to do some of -- we tried to group the terms in a logical way for the Court. I'm planning to do some of the terms. Basically there's several groups of terms where we -- the basic difference is we think we should have a simple definition. We think they're adding too much stuff in the way of negative limitations and so on.

And then there's some terms where the main issue is whether it should or should not be construed as a means-plus-function type element, and my partner Tom Makin is going to handle those. And then the other side would then present their tutorial. And so that's the way we basically lined it up.

I should mention one other thing. If the Court has time at the end of this, we do have still some problems with discovery. The parties do keep talking, but we're still at a
