Plaintiff NuVasive, Inc. ("NuVasive,") and Defendants Alphatec Holdings, Inc. and Alphatec Spine, Inc. ("Alphatec" and, with NuVasive, the "Parties") hereby submit this Joint Stipulation to extend the deadline to file Reply Memoranda of Points and Authorities in support of the Parties' respective motions for summary judgment and/or motion to exclude expert opinions, up to and including February 26, 2021. In support hereof, the Parties state as follows:

On January 26, 2021, NuVasive filed a Motion to Exclude Untimely, Unsupported, and Improper Expert Opinions (Doc. No. 302), as well as a Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 303). That same day, Alphatec also filed a Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 304).
