

The Court orders that the following equipment and tools will be brought to the Court and operated by counsel for Defendants Alphatec Holdings, Inc. and Alphatec Spine, Inc. (collectively, "Alphatec"), and Ted Haw, Trial Presentation Specialist of Innovative Trial Services, on **June 29, 2021** for the Oral Argument relating to the pending Motions for Summary Judgment and NuVasive Inc.'s Motion to Exclude Expert Opinions:

- 5 laptop computers;
- Cables, wireless presentation remotes, electronic pointer, keyboards, mice, power cords, and power strips;
- Alphatec's surgical instruments at issue in this litigation, including but not limited to Alphatec's BattalionTM, TranscendTM, and IdentiTiTM implants; and
- Certain NuVasive surgical instruments, including but not limited to certain NuVasive CoRoent® implants.

To the extent additional electronic equipment or surgical tools related to, but not otherwise listed above, are needed to facilitate the hearing, such additional equipment or tools are also permitted.
