- 8 • Cables, wireless presentation remotes, electronic pointer, keyboards,
9 mice, power cords, and power strips;
- 10 • Alphatec’s surgical instruments at issue in this litigation, including but
11 not limited to Alphatec’s Battalion™, Transcend™, and IdentiTi™
12 implants; and
- 13 • Certain NuVasive surgical instruments, including but not limited to
14 certain NuVasive CoRoent® implants.

15 To the extent additional electronic equipment or surgical tools related to, but
16 not otherwise listed above, are needed to facilitate the hearing, such additional
17 equipment or tools are also permitted.
