
1 The Court orders that the following equipment and tools may be brought to the
2 court and operated by counsel for Defendants Alphatec Holdings, Inc. and Alphatec
3 Spine, Inc., (collectively, “Alphatec”) and Robert Wilson, Technology Specialist of
4 Evoke Technology & Design, on February 28, 2022 for technical testing and set-up;
5 and trial starting on **March 1, 2022 and to continue through March 10, 2022 [Doc.
6 No. 368]:**

- 7 • Laptop computers;
- 8 • Cables, wireless presentation remotes, laser pointers, keyboards, mice,
9 power cords, power strips, monitors, table, easels and pads;
- 10 • Demonstrative models of the spine, surgical instruments, and surgical
11 trays including the physical exhibits listed on Defendants’ Trial
12 Exhibits List (Doc. No. 355 at Exhibit 4), such as the surgical tools
13 listed as DTX-210 through DTX-224 (p. 3), DTX-414 through DTX-
14 428 (p. 6); as well as DTX-1056 and DTX-1074 added to subsequent
15 Defendants’ Amended Trial Exhibit Lists.

16 To the extent additional electronic equipment or surgical tools related to, but
17 not otherwise listed above, are needed to facilitate the trial, such additional
18 equipment, tools, and demonstratives are also permitted.
