1 The Court orders that the following equipment and tools may be brought to the
2 court and operated by counsel for Plaintiff NuVasive, Inc. (“NuVasive”) and Bill
3 Smith, Trial Presentation Specialist of Advanced Courtroom Technologies on
4 February 28, 2022 for technical testing and set-up; and trial starting on **March 1, 2022**
5 **and to continue through March 10, 2022 [Doc. No. 368]:**

- 6 • Laptop computers;
- 7 • Cables, wireless presentation remotes, laser pointers, keyboards, mice,
8 power cords, power strips, monitors, table, easels and pads;
- 9 • The physical exhibits listed on NuVasive’s Trial Exhibits List (Doc.
10 No. 355 at Exhibit 3), including the surgical tools listed as PTX-426
11 through PTX-444 (pp. 39-40), as well as PTX-1882 through PTX-1890
12 (p. 169); and
- 13 • Demonstrative models of the spine, surgical instruments, and surgical
14 trays.

15 To the extent additional electronic equipment or surgical tools related to, but
16 not otherwise listed above, are needed to facilitate the trial, such additional
17 equipment, tools, and demonstratives are also permitted.

18 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
