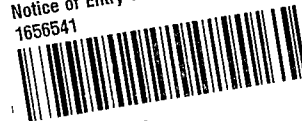

24 Defendant Woloschuk's motion to compel arbitration and stay court proceedings is
25 GRANTED. The present proceedings are hereby STAYED pending completion of the
26 arbitration.

27 Defendant Woloschuk has established the existence of an arbitration agreement between
28 the parties and there is no basis to deny enforcement of the agreement under CCP §
1281.2.
