**DEFENDANT POLYCOM'S SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER OR OTHERWISE RESPOND
TO PLAINTIFF'S ORIGINAL COMPLAINT**

Defendant Polycom, by and through undersigned counsel, requests the Court grant a fifteen (15) day extension of time to answer and/or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Original Complaint. This is Polycom's second request for an extension.

Plaintiff's Original Complaint was filed on November 10, 2017. Doc. 1. Polycom was served on December 4, 2017, making Polycom's answer or response originally due on December 26, 2017. Doc. 14. On December 22, 2017, the Court granted Polycom's unopposed request for an extension of its deadline to answer or respond by thirty (30) days, until January 25, 2018. Doc. 16. Polycom requested Plaintiff grant Polycom an additional fifteen (15) day extension, until February 9, 2018, to which Plaintiff has agreed.

Polycom requests this second extension of time to provide further time to investigate the facts and allegations in the Complaint, to finalize its selection of litigation counsel, and to allow its selected counsel to review the issues and prepare a response.

Polycom does not seek this extension for any improper purpose, and no prejudice will arise from the extension.

Pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 6.1(E), undersigned counsel certifies that a copy of this Motion will be served on undersigned's client.

Wherefore, Polycom respectfully moves that the Court enter an order extending the deadline to file an answer or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Original Complaint, for fifteen (15) days, through and including February 9, 2018.
