The foregoing, having been considered by the Court, is hereby:

ORDER: SCHEDULE ARGUMENT

The matter having the following filing numbers are scheduled for hearing on the court's oral argument short calendar: #216.

The party opposing the scheduled matter shall, if not yet done, file a response at least 5 days before the hearing date.

The hearing shall be held on: Monday, August 19, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.

Counsel shall make good faith efforts to resolve the dispute, and on or before the hearing date, BOTH counsel shall file sworn affidavits attesting that such good faith efforts were made but were unsuccessful.

In order to advance possible resolution of this dispute, within 14 days plaintiff's counsel shall provide defense counsel with the names and addresses of five doctors in the same field as the proposed independent medical examiner for the defense to consider.

If the dispute is resolved before the hearing date, the plaintiff shall so notify the short calendar clerk in writing promptly, the matters may be marked off, and the parties need not appear for this matter.
