  - (b) Summary Process actions
  - (c) Applications for change of name
  - (d) Probate appeals
  - (e) Administrative appeals

- (f) Proceedings pertaining to arbitration
- (g) Any actions or proceedings in which an attachment, garnishment or replevy is sought
- (h) Entry and Detainer proceedings
- (i) Housing Code Enforcement actions
