ORDER

On 9 November 2021, the Court entered a modified claim construction schedule. *See* Order, ECF No. 64. On 12 January 2022, plaintiffs filed an unopposed motion to modify the claim construction briefing schedule. *See* Pls.’ Unopposed Mot. to Amend the Scheduling Order, ECF No. 65.

According to plaintiffs, the current schedule conflicts with plaintiffs’ counsel’s trial schedule in a separate proceeding and plaintiffs’ representatives need additional time to review the opening claim construction brief prepared by plaintiffs’ counsel. *Id.* at 1. Plaintiffs state the government does not oppose their motion. *Id.* For good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** plaintiffs’ unopposed motion to modify the claim construction schedule, ECF No. 65. The Court **ADOPTS** the following modified claim construction briefing schedule:

Plaintiffs file their opening claim construction brief	14 January 2022	24 January 2022
The government files its responsive claim construction brief	18 February 2022	28 February 2022
Plaintiffs file their reply claim construction brief	4 March 2022	14 March 2022
The government files its sur-reply claim construction brief	18 March 2022	28 March 2022

The parties submit the joint claim construction statement and propose dates for the <i>Markman</i> hearing	25 March 2022	4 April 2022
If desired, the parties may submit a joint technical tutorial to the Court	1 April 2022	11 April 2022
<i>Markman</i> hearing	To be scheduled	To be scheduled
Deadline for the government to produce technical documents for additional agencies named in the second amended complaint	15 April 2022	25 April 2022
