## **ORDER**

On 9 November 2021, the Court entered a modified claim construction schedule. *See* Order, ECF No. 64. On 12 January 2022, plaintiffs filed an unopposed motion to modify the claim construction briefing schedule. *See* Pls.' Unopposed Mot. to Amend the Scheduling Order, ECF No. 65.

According to plaintiffs, the current schedule conflicts with plaintiffs' counsel's trial schedule in a separate proceeding and plaintiffs' representatives need additional time to review the opening claim construction brief prepared by plaintiffs' counsel. *Id.* at 1. Plaintiffs state the government does not oppose their motion. *Id.* For good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** plaintiffs' unopposed motion to modify the claim construction schedule, ECF No. 65.
