ORDER

On 10 March 2022, plaintiffs filed an unopposed motion to amend the Court’s previous scheduling order, ECF No. 75. *See* Pl.’s Unopposed Mot. to Amend the Scheduling Order, ECF No. 76. Plaintiffs explain a medical emergency delayed plaintiffs’ preparation of their claim construction briefs presently due on 11 March 2022. *Id.* at 1. Plaintiff states the government does not oppose its motion. *Id.*

For good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** plaintiffs’ motion to amend the current scheduling order and **ADOPTS** the following modified claim construction briefing schedule:

Plaintiffs file their opening claim construction briefs and any expert declaration they may rely upon	11 March 2022	14 March 2022
The government files its responsive claim construction briefs	25 April 2022	29 April 2022
Plaintiffs file their reply claim construction briefs	9 May 2022	13 May 2022
The government files its surreply claim construction briefs	23 May 2022	27 May 2022

Plaintiffs file their surreply claim construction brief regarding indefiniteness terms	6 June 2022	10 June 2022
The parties submit the joint claim construction statement and propose dates for the <i>Markman</i> hearing	13 June 2022	17 June 2022
If desired, parties may submit joint technical tutorial to the Court	20 June 2022	24 June 2022
<i>Markman</i> hearing	To be scheduled	To be scheduled
Deadline for the government to produce technical documents for additional agencies named in the second amended complaint	5 July 2022	8 July 2022
