By publication of a notice in the *Federal Register* on May 2, 2012, pursuant to subsection (b) of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, the Commission instituted this investigation to determine:

[W]hether there is a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain cameras and mobile devices, related software and firmware, and components thereof and products containing same that infringe one or more of claims 1–3 and 22 of the ‘003 patent [U.S. Patent No. 6,665,003] and claims 1–3, 10, 20, 27–29, 36, and 37 of the ‘284 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,477,284], and whether an industry in the United States exists as required by subsection (a)(2) of section 337.

The complainant is HumanEyes Technologies, Ltd. of Jerusalem, Israel. The respondents are Sony Corporation of Tokyo, Japan; Sony Corporation of America of New York, New York; Sony Electronics Inc. of San Diego, California; Sony Mobile Communications AB of London, United Kingdom; and Sony Mobile Communications (USA) Inc. of Atlanta, Georgia.

The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is a party in this investigation. *Id.*

Based upon the complaint, the notice of investigation, and the parties’ discovery

statements, the undersigned has determined that the initial determination on alleged violation of section 337 shall be due on May 3, 2013, and that the target date for completion of this investigation is September 3, 2013, which is 16 months after institution of the investigation. *See* 19 C.F.R. § 210.51(a); 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(a)(1)(i).
