We write on behalf of all parties in the civil action *Cubist Pharms., Inc. v. Fresenius Kabi USA, LLC*, C.A. No. 14-914 -GMS (the "Fresenius action").

As the Court is no doubt aware, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit has affirmed the Court's judgment of patent invalidity in *Cubist Pharms., Inc. v. Hospira, Inc.*, C.A. No. 12-367-GMS (the "Hospira action"), and denied Cubist's petition for further review of that affirmance. Today, the Federal Circuit issued its mandate. The Hospira and Fresenius actions involve the same patents and claims.

In accord with their stipulation, D.I. 78, the parties to the Fresenius action respectfully request immediate entry of the attached Consent Judgment, which dismisses the action in its entirety with prejudice.
