# JOINT MOTION TO FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT AND STIPULATION REGARDING NOTICE

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a)(2) and the Court's Scheduling Order (Dkt. No. 37), which provides a deadline of January 15, 2018 for motions to amend the pleadings, Plaintiff Godo Kaisha IP Bridge 1 ("IPB") and Defendant OmniVision Technologies, Inc. ("OmniVision") request that the Court order that Plaintiff Godo Kaisha IP Bridge 1 ("IPB") may file an amended complaint removing its allegations of infringement for U.S. Patent Nos. 7,279,727; 7,709,900; and 7,126,174 (the "Dismissed Claims") within seven days of the Court's grant of this motion. The amended complaint removes original Counts IV, VIII, and IX.

The parties stipulate and agree that the requested amendment is made without prejudice and that the original complaint and litigation of this case do not constitute notice of infringement to OmniVision for U.S. Patent Nos. 7,279,727; 7,709,900; and 7,126,174.

The parties further stipulate that IPB's original filing of the Dismissed Claims shall not be referenced in this action for any purpose, including any request for attorneys' fees or costs based on an allegation that their filing was in any way improper or unsupported by a reasonable pre-suit investigation.
