A computer network for providing a game environment for a plurality of participants,</p>	<p>The Accused Product meets the recited claim language because it provides a computer network for providing a game environment for a plurality of participants.</p> <p>For example and without limitation, World of Warcraft includes realm servers that are comprised of many classes of servers both lower and higher than the realm level; including specialized servers that manage cross-realm functionalities. These servers and realm servers connect to provide an environment where the realm servers and other classes of servers are peers that facilitate raids, instances, dungeons, commerce, player versus player, battlegrounds, scenarios, arenas, connected realms, flexible raiding, chat channels, account servers, auction houses, garrisons, world events, party/parties, guilds and cross-realm areas.</p> <p>For example and without limitation, the following screen capture shows that WOW provides an online game where players from around the world play in a virtual world. WOW is considered a Massive Multiplayer Online Role Playing game, where thousands of players can be in the same game world at the same time.</p>
