Exhibit C: Summary of Certain Indefiniteness and § 101 Issues Addressed or Will Be Addressed In Claim Construction

The following table summarizes the impact certain indefiniteness and § 101 arguments that have been addressed or will be addressed during claim construction. In the table below, the “X” indicates that the argument applies and the gray box indicates that the argument does not apply. As summarized below, only seven claims can potentially remain after the claim construction process is resolved.¹
