- Lois Kwasigroch was not aware of any errors in the Patent Trial and Appeal Board's ("PTAB") analysis regarding the validity of the '196 and '379 patents;
- Ms. Kwasigroch was not aware of any invalidity arguments or any prior art that was not presented to and considered by the PTAB when it found that the '196 and '379 patents are not invalid; and
- 3. Ms. Kwasigroch did not have a basis for believing that the '196, '379, and '811 dosing patents are invalid.
