1 of asserted claims and prior art references. I'm totally 2 unprepared to deal with that at this juncture. But we can at 3 least chat about it. 4 We are going to talk a little bit about the motion to 5 amend the protective order and the filing of the motion to 6 transfer under seal. 7 There is also BP's motion to sever and stay. It 8 seems to me it is related directly to where this is going to be 9 heard on the transfer issue. 10 There are a number of other pending motions in 11 16-CV-2690 that probably I can't get to at this juncture unless 12 they were directly related to where we're going to hear their 13 case for confidentiality issues. 14 We have a lot of motions to file surreplies. And I don't know whether that is something that is routinely approved 15 16 in the Eastern District of Texas so that everyone has gotten 17 used to doing that. We don't routinely approve them.
