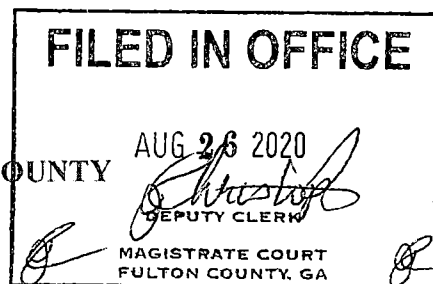

ORDER

In the above-styled actions, a Motion for Dismissal on the grounds that the vehicle in question is derelict; however, there was no evidence present to support this claim. The claim may be supported by making a showing of compliance with 40-11-9 by providing any one of the following:

- (1) By showing a vehicle was appraised at a total value of less than \$300.00.
- (2) A determination that the Georgia Department of Revenue has determined the vehicle is derelict.
- (3) An invoice showing the vehicle was sold for scrap or parts.

Based on the foregoing, Plaintiffs Motion to Dismiss is DENIED.
