

**ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S RESPONSE AND OBJECTION TO DEFENDANT'S
REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS TO NON-PARTY GOLDFEIN
CLAIMS MANAGEMENT**

Plaintiff filed this lawsuit on April 24, 2019 to recover for injuries allegedly sustained in an automobile collision with Defendant. She seeks recovery of lost wages, among other damages. Consequently, Defendant sent a request for documents to Plaintiff's employer. Plaintiff objected on the grounds that any documents from her employer are irrelevant, and are not likely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. The Court disagrees. Plaintiff's employment and records are entirely relevant to her claim, and are reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Plaintiff's objection is DENIED. Plaintiff is ORDERED to respond fully and completely to discovery within 15 days of the entry of this Order.
