ORDER FOR STAY OF DISCOVERY

This matter came before the Court on Defendants' Emergency Motion for Protective Order as to Depositions filed October 8, 2019.

A number of factors weigh in favor of the Court granting the motion. First, discovery seems to have reached an impasse prior to end of the discovery period. Second, multiple motions have been filed which will need to be ruled on prior to the resolution of the discovery disputes.
