12 Q. Can you please state your full name and address for the
13 record.

14 A. Robert Cedergren, 310 Cyprus Lane, Libertyville,
15 Illinois.

16 Q. And you received your undergraduate degree from the
17 University of Illinois, correct?

18 A. Yes.

19 Q. And that was a bachelor's of science?

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. And that was 1988, correct?

22 A. Correct.
