
**ORDER NO. 18: GRANTING RESPONDENT APPLE INC.'S MOTION FOR LEAVE  
TO FILE MOTIONS *IN LIMINE* OUT OF TIME**

(March 11, 2022)

On March 10, 2022, respondent Apple Inc. (“Apple”) moved (1266-021) for leave to file corrected versions of its motions *in limine* to include attachments of certain exhibits cited therein. Apple explains the omitted exhibits are trial exhibits otherwise stamped and available to the parties. Mot. at 1.
