**ORDER NO. 20: GRANTING RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR SHORTENED TIME
TO RESPOND**

(March 21, 2022)

On March 21, 2022, respondent Apple, Inc. ("Apple") moved (1266-028) for leave to amend its Pre-Hearing Statement. The motion included a request for a shortened response time of two business days for complainant AliveCor, Inc. ("AliveCor") and three business days for the Commission Investigative Staff ("Staff"). Mot. at 1. The motion represents that AliveCor does not oppose the shortened response time and that Staff intends to comply with its three day limit. *See id.*

Given the advanced stage of the investigation, Apple's motion (1266-028) is granted. I hereby order that any response from AliveCor to the motion for leave must be filed no later than March 23, 2022; and any response from Staff must be filed no later than March 24, 2022.
