**ORDER NO. 29: GRANTING JOINT MOTION OF THE PRIVATE PARTIES FOR
EXTENSION OF THE DEADLINE TO FILE REPLY POST-TRIAL
BRIEFS**

(April 19, 2022)

On April 19, 2022, complainant AliveCor, Inc. (“AliveCor”) and respondent Apple Inc. (“Apple”) moved (1266-031) to extend the deadline for reply post-trial briefs from April 25, 2022 to April 29, 2022. The motion argues the “modest extension is warranted given the various holidays that occurred on and following the filing of the parties’ initial post-trial briefs” (Mot. at 2), and represents, “[t]he Commission Investigative Staff does not oppose the requested relief” (*id.* at 3).

There being no opposition, the joint motion (1266-031) is granted.
