**ORDER NO. 10: GRANTING COMMISSION INVESTIGATIVE STAFF'S
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE ITS RESPONSE TO
MOTION DOCKET NO. 1347-003**

On April 21, 2023, the Commission Investigative Staff moved (Mot. 1347-004) for leave to file its response to Respondent Google LLC's motion to amend its Response to the Complaint and Notice of Investigation. Staff's motion indicates that it calendared the response due date for Google's motion without noticing the official received date on EDIS, and thus filed its motion one day late, on April 21, 2023.
