**JOINT STATUS REPORT NOTIFYING THE COURT THAT
THE PATENT OFFICE HAS FOUND ALL CHALLENGED CLAIMS
IN ALL ASSERTED PATENTS TO BE UNPATENTABLE**

Pursuant to the Court's order staying the case (D.I. 42), Plaintiff Aplix IP Holdings Corporation ("Aplix") and Defendants Sony Computer Entertainment Inc. ("SCEI") and Sony Computer Entertainment America LLC ("SCEA") notify the Court that the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office's Patent Trial and Appeal Board ("Patent Office") has issued its final written decisions in all the Inter Partes Reviews ("IPR") filed by SCEA and opposed by Aplix regarding the five patents asserted by Aplix in this case. The Patent Office held that all challenged claims of Aplix's asserted patents are unpatentable. The table below summarizes the Patent Office's decisions, which are attached as Appendices A through G to this joint notice.
